Biur Chametz

*As a community service, the following organizations will hold **public biur chametz** on Friday, April 11, 2025: The Agudah will be from 8 AM to 11:30 AM at the Lincolnwood Town Center – Lower Level, southeast parking lot. (Enter from McCormick via Town Center Drive.), and F.R.E.E. of Chicago – The Bellows Center will be from 8 AM to 11 AM in their parking lot at 2935 W. Devon Ave. in Chicago.

Guide for Wedding Dates

During the *Sefira* period, i.e., from Pesach until *Shavuot* (June 2-3), with certain exceptions, weddings should not be conducted. For information, consult a Rabbi. Also, the Three Weeks begin with *Shiva Asar b'Tammuz* – Saturday night, July 12th - fast on Sunday, July 13th – and culminate with *Tisha B'Av* – fast begins Saturday night, August 2nd through Sunday, August 3rd.
